

Pillow Booth Policy

The success of the pillow booth and therefore the club is dependent upon entire club participation in working the designated (usually 6) number of nights at the booth or helping with other related activities such as laundry parties, monthly co-chairs, webmistress, and sewing of pillow covers. Anyone unable to safely carry out these activities or have work schedule conflicts should discuss their situation with the booth co-chairs. As a result of our volunteer hours, OSF provides free play tickets (which may vary from season to season) to our club members who have fulfilled their pillow booth responsibilities or have been excused. This list of names is sent to OSF annually by the roster manager. Any member who does not use the tickets and wishes to have her name remove from the mailing list may do so and will be reviewed annually.

Non-members who have previously worked in the booth may sign up for no more than 3 nights with preference given to club members. The hours worked by the non-member will not be credited to the club member. These non-members are welcome to work as a third person on busy booth nights.
